**I. Church Relation Ministry:**

**Pastor Support:** CMC Cambodia has provided partial support for ten pastors in four provinces. The support helps the pastors with their daily expenses during their travel to cell-churches. It also operates other Christian ministries in target areas. Eight pastors have received partial support of \$50 per month and two others received \$100 per month. They serve their own churches with good results.

new believers attend churches near their houses. He preaches at four services every Sunday. Pastor Rin and his wife attend a monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. They travel to a group of churches to teach the Bible. He teaches what he has learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ. Pastor Rin and his wife visit and pray for church families, including a Bible study with them. Praise God for using him to bless people. \$100 per month from CMC supports his ministry.

**5-Pator Soun Chanroum:** Every week



Pastor Chanroum travels to villages around Siem Reap province. On Wednesday to Sunday he serves the church in Rolous village, worshipping God with 15 children, 3 youths and 2



adults. He is teaching Genesis to them. On Wednesday and Thursday evening he teaches the Bible to a group of children and adults. Sunday afternoon he preaches



at the CMC center to twelve people. Pastor Chanroum leads another church service in Siem Reap and again at Rolus village with 25 people. Daily he travels to visit Christian families and church elders, praying for them, encouraging and building up their knowledge of the Bible. **II. Christian Education Ministry:**

**A) Pastors and leaders training:** Please pray for our next training of Pastors and leaders in November 2020. Expenses include:

1. Local travel in country for Rev. Radha Manickam and Rev. Paul Goodner.
  2. Printing of materials for training in three provinces
  3. Meals for training classes in three provinces.
  4. Room and board in country.
- Please pray and contribute to equip our pastors and leaders in Cambodia so they will be able to win souls for Christ. Students in three provinces will attend also.

**B) English Class:** Since the pandemic virus of COVID-19 spread all over the world, the Cambodia Government has

announced to close all kinds of school in country. We are the one of other school that government advise to close and follow to their rule to prevent the effection of virus until the new announcement to reopen school. At the CMC center we have paid teachers. The cost is \$200 monthly. At the CMC center we have 102 students who are studying English in four classes as follow:

- 1) English Time III, with 24 students
- 2) New English with 30 students.
- 3) New English Elementary, with 29 students
- 4) New English Beginner, with 19 students.

**III Church Building Ministry:** From CMC Cambodia is raising funds for Church building projects and housing for poor rural families. A complete church building costs \$25,000 and a house \$3,000. Please contact CMC for more detailed information.

**IV. Care Ministry**

**A) Well project Activities:** Please pray for our water well projects next year. One well costs \$2,000. Please pray and consider giving the needed funds to help community people need clean water. Please keep pray for our water well project in year that plan more to drill for poor family in need.

**B) Support Students:**

**Other Activities at the CMC center:**

**A)** In addition to Sunday services we also have morning devotions.

Every Saturday afternoon Pastor Chanroum teaches Bible to Five people.
