Dear friends, families, and partners in Christ's ministry: The Lord is good to us and our family during this pandemic time. I pray that that you, your family, and your church are doing well.

During this bad time for us God's ministry is still doing well and continues to grow in the Pacific Northwest as well as in other parts of the US and Cambodia. We praise God for his goodness. We thank the Lord for keeping us in good health to continue serving him among the Cambodian people.

In the last prayer letter, I introduced three pastors new pastors that we help with partial financial support, Pastor Phay Than, Pastor Prom Prin. and Pastor Roeun Ron. We thank the Lord for our church in Seattle picking-up their support for one year. These three pastors serve the Lord in their region of Cambodia.

Pastor Cheam Rin and his wife faithfully serve the Lord among the Cambodian people in his local and surrounding villages and provinces. They lead 12 people to Christ and lead services every Sunday with 105 people in



attendance. Pastor Cheam Rin preaches the gospel everywhere he goes. He and his wife visit people and pray with them during the hard times. He also equip leaders by using what he learned from the CMC training program.

Pastor Chan Roum recently married and we praise God for the new couple. He and his wife serve the Lord in three churches by sharing messages every Sunday. He teaches a Bible study every Wednesday through Friday. He and his wife visit people with whom they work



and pray with them. Even during the pandemic they use every opportunity to serve God among the Cambodian people in their area.

Pastor Phan Sophun and his wife faithfully serve among the Cambodian people in Pursat Province. He is still pastoring his church of 95 members in Pursat town. Pastor Sophun and his wife take time to visit people with whom they work, focusing on new new cell groups that they start. They share the love of Christ and preach to people in their towns and nearby villages. This quarter 35 people accepted the Lord through their ministry. Praise God for his goodness!

Pastor Mam SamOeun serve the Lord among the Cambodian people in Siem Reap Province. Pastor SamOeun is pastoring his church an hour's drive outside of Siem Reap city. His church has 45 people in attendance. He travels to many villages in his area to share the love of Christ. In this quarter he led 48 people to Christ. After leading them to Christ he gives them a Bible. Pastor SamOeun leads services in the open air every Sunday due to government restrictions on group meeting. Pastor SamOeun trains leaders in the new churches that he starts by using what he has learned from our class at the CMC Center.

Pastor Khem Bai is pastoring a church of 32 people outside of Siem Reap city in another village. Pastor Bai travesl to visit people and pray with them. He conducts weekly Bible study with old and new believers. He uses what he learns from us to train new leaders to serve God. In this quarter he leads 8 people to Christ. Praise God for his faithful service to the Lord.

Pastor Hun Sareth is another pastor that we support. He started a new church with 15 people in attendance. He spend time with people by visiting them regularly. He prays with them and leads Bible study in his areas. In this quarter he led 8 people to Christ and he also started teaching them about the role of leadership in ministry from what he has learned at the CMC Center.

Pastor Phay Than is pastor in the Northwest region that we support. Pasto Than is pastors a new church of 35 people. He visit other areas and

started new cell groups. He lead Bible study groups to help them understand their faith in Christ. In this quarter pastor Than lead 10 people to Christ.

Another pastor that we support is Pastor Prom Prin. He is pastor of a church of 25 people. Pastor Prin visits people in nearby villages and share Christ with people. In this quarter he led 28 people to Christ. Pastor Prin started Bible study groups for these new believers and helps them to know more about Jesus and their walk with him.

We praise the Lord for his goodness through his faithful servants like pastor SamOeun. We at CMC thank you for supporting God's servants in Cambodia.

Please pray for all the faithful pastors to have wisdom and guidance while serving God as they win Cambodians for Christ. **Pray** also for their faithfulness in serving the Lord.

#### Cambodia ministries

I was planning to return to Cambodia in November, but the Lord did not open the door for the trip. The government closed down all large group gatherings. Please **pray** that God will use our previous training to help his servants in Cambodia expand their ministries and train others to serve him. **Pray** also that God would work through those who hear of the needs in Cambodia and will partner with us to reach Cambodia for Christ.

I thank you for your prayers and generous gifts which covered the needs for my previous trips. Please **pray** for wisdom to perform my duties as a teacher and trainer to our beloved pastors and leaders in Cambodia. Each trip I need to raise \$4,500 in order to conduct the leadership training.
