Another pastor that we started to support is Pastor Hun Sareth. Pastor Sareth is another trainees in our training class. He also takes what he learns from us to train other people in his congregation. Pastor Sareth heard the call to serve God and even though he is poor, he stepped forward to serve God anyway.
