Dear friends, families, and partners in Christ's ministry: During this pandemic time I pray that that you, your family, and your church are doing well. All our family members are grateful to the Lord for our good health.

We praise God that even during this bad time for us his ministry is still doing well and continues to grow and is doing well in the Pacific Northwest as well as other parts of the US and Cambodia. We thank the Lord and are grateful to him for allowing us to continue to serve him among the Cambodian people here and in Cambodia.

In the last prayer letter I introduced two pastors that we started supporting. I now introduce to you three new pastors that we help with partial support so they can serve the Lord. First is Pastor Phay Than. Pastor Than is a pastor and also a farmer in northwest Siem Reap province. He accepted the Lord while he was in a refugee camp in the late 70s and heard the call to ministry in the late 90s. Pastor Than has been one of our trainees for a few years now. He takes what he learns from us and trains other people in his congregation. Pastor Than and his wife have seven children; some are still in his care. He is poor but serves the Lord without complaint. We learned that he barely has enough to live on even with his work on his farm. With some of the funds we have we decided to support him so he can continue to serve the Lord. Pastor Phay Than not only pastors a church in his remote village but also starts other churches as well. He is a faithful pastor and church planter and we want to see him continue to serve the Lord and start more churches in Cambodia.

Another pastor that we started to support is Pastor Prom Prin. Pastor Prin is another trainee in our training class. He also takes what he learns from us to train other people in his congregation. Pastor Prin heard the call to serve God and even though he is poor, he stepped forward to serve God anyway. Pastor Prin and his wife have four children. Pastor Prin also works hard with his community and is

The third pastor that we support is Pastor Roeun Ron. Pastor Ron is also one of our trainees in our training class. He takes what he learns from us to train other people in his congregation. Pastor Ron is working hard with his community and is about to help start a new congregation in northwest Cambodia. Pastor Cheam Rin and his wife faithfully serve the Lord among the Cambodian people in his local and surrounding villages and provinces. They share the love of Christ with many people wherever they travel. Last month they led 40+ people to Christ and baptized them.

Pastor Chan Roum started meeting through the internet for those who are able to join him and study the Bible with him. He has not yet been able to start sharing Christ with the teenagers in our language classes on Friday night at the CMC Training Center.

Pastor Phan Sophun and his wife faithfully serve the Lord among the Cambodian people in Pursat Province. They also share the love of Christ and preaches to many people in their towns and nearby villages. God is good!

Pastor Mam SamOeun serve the Lord among the Cambodian people in Siem Reap Province. He shares the love of Christ with many people in their towns and nearby villages. After leading them to

Christ he gives them a Bible. Pastor SamOeun leads services in the open air every Sunday. We praise the Lord for his goodness through his faithful servants like pastor SamOeun. We at CMC thank you for supporting God's servants in Cambodia.

Please pray for all the faithful pastors to have wisdom and guidance while serving God in Cambodia as they win Cambodians for Christ. **Pray** also for their faithfulness in serving the Lord.

I received a text from our students in Cambodia asking when I will return to conduct training again. I hope to return to Cambodia in November if the Lord open the door. Please **pray** that God will use this training to help his servants in Cambodia expand their ministries. **Pray** also that God would work through those who hear of the needs in Cambodia and will partner with us to reach Cambodia for Christ.
