

Quarterly Report October to December 2020

Dear friends, families and partners in Christ’s ministry, we pray that you, your family and church are doing well. I thank you for your generous gifts to help cover the needs of our family and ministry here in Cambodia. We thank the Lord for allowing us to serve him this year, and we are looking forward to expanding God’s ministry in Cambodia in 2021. We shared the love of God in the local community and provinces.

**I. Church Relation Ministry:**

**Pastor Support:** CMC Cambodia has provided partial support for ten pastors in four provinces. The support helps the pastors with their daily expenses during their travel to cell-churches. It also operates other Christian ministries in target areas. Five pastors have received partial support of \$50 per month and Five others received \$100 per month. They serve their own churches with good results.

**-Pastor Mam Sam Oeun:** Pastor SamOeun’s



church has 45 people in attendance every Sunday. He travels to other villages outside of his hometown and preaches the gospel of Jesus

Christ through leaflets and sharing testimonies of Christian life with non-believers in villages. Forty-Eight new people have trusted Jesus as their Savior in the last three months. Some attend different churches near their houses. **Please pray for Pastor Sam Oeun.** He



wants a Church building, funds for food relief and good health for himself and the



believers. He receives \$100 per month from CMC for his ministry through donations received for him.

**2-Pastor Phan Sophun:** Pastor



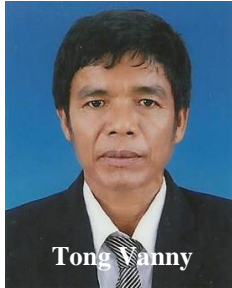
Sophun’s church has 95 people in attendance on Sunday. Pastor Sophun visits cell-churches, teaching leaders and church members. He preaches the gospel of Jesus

Christ through leaflets and Christian testimonies to non-believers in villages outside of his area. This quarter 35 people have accepted Jesus as their savior. They attend church services close



to their houses. \$50 per month from CMC supports his ministry through donations received for him. **Please pray for Pastor Sophun.** He desires to complete his church building.

**3-Pastor Tong Vanny:** Pastor Vanny’s



church has 15 people in attendance on Sunday. Pastor Vanny preaches at his cell-church every weekend. He preaches the gospel of Jesus

Christ to people outside of his village. He meets with new believers to teach them the Bible. He prays for the sick from 6pm to 7pm. Five people accepted Jesus as their savior this quarter. Some of the new believers attend church near their houses. **Please pray for Pastor Vanny’s** economic needs, his health, and for new believers to come to faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. \$50 per month from CMC supports his ministry through donations received for him.



**4-Pastor Cheam Rin:** Pastor Rin and his wife travel to villages and schools outside of their hometown to share the love of God. 105 people usually attend and listen to the good news of God. They preach the good news of salvation in Jesus to everyone. 12 people believed in Jesus as their Savior. The new believers attend churches near their houses. He preaches at four services every Sunday. Pastor Rin and his wife attend a monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. They travel to a group of churches to teach the Bible. He teaches what he has learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. Pastor Rin and his wife



visit and pray for church families, including a Bible study with them. Praise God for using him to bless people. \$100 per month from CMC supports his ministry.





**5-Pator Soun Chanroum:** Every week Pastor Chanroum travels to villages around Siem Reap province. On Wednesday to Friday and Sunday he serves the church in Rolous village, worshipping God with 8 children, 5 youths and 2 adults. He is teaching the book call “Living in the Spirit” to them. On Wednesday and Thursday evening he teaches the Bible to a group of children



and adults. Sunday afternoon he preaches at the CMC center to 12 people. Pastor Chanroum leads another church service in Siem Reap and again at Rolous village with 15 people. Daily he travels to visit Christian families and church elders, praying for them, encouraging and building up their knowledge of the Bible. Pastor Chanroum attends a course called Bible Interpretation and Preparation for Preaching. \$100 per month from CMC supports his ministry.

**6-Pastor Khoem Bai:** Pastor Bai’s church has 32 people in attendance on Sunday. Pastor Bai visits cell-churches teaching leaders and church members. 25 people usually attend and listen to the good news of God that he shares through leaflets and Christian testimonies to non-believers in villages outside of his area. This quarter eight people have accepted Jesus as their savior. Four new believers were baptized in this quarter. They attend church services close to their houses. He preaches at two services every Sunday. Pastor Bai attends a



monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. He travels to a group of churches to teach the Bible. He teaches what he has learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. \$50 per month from CMC supports his ministry through donations received for him. **Please pray for**



**Pastor Bai,** his economic needs, his health, and for new believers to come to faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God.

**7-Pastor Hun Saret:** Pastor Sareth’s church has 15 people in attendance on Sunday. Pastor Saret visits cell-churches, teaching leaders and church members. He preaches the gospel of Jesus Christ



through leaflets and Christian testimonies to non-believers in villages outside of his area. This quarter eight people have accepted Jesus as their savior. They attend church services close to their houses. \$50 per month from CMC supports his ministry through



donations received for him. **Please pray for Pastor Saret,** his economic needs, his health, and for new believers to come to faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God.

**8-Pastor Phay Than:** Pastor Than’s church has 35 people in attendance on Sunday. Pastor Than visits cell-churches teaching leaders and church members. He preaches the gospel of Jesus Christ through leaflets and Christian

testimonies to non-believers in villages outside of his area. This quarter 10 people have accepted Jesus as their savior. They attend church services close to their houses. \$50 per month from CMC supports his ministry through donations received for him. **Please pray for Pastor Than,** his economic needs, his health, and for new believers to come to faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God.



**9-Pastor Prom Prin:** Pastor Prin’s church has 25 people in attendance on Sunday. Pastor Prin visits cell-churches to teach church members. He preaches the gospel of Jesus Christ through leaflets and



Christian testimonies to non-believers in villages outside of his area. This quarter 28 people have accepted Jesus as their savior. 8 new believers were baptized this quarter. They attend church services close to their houses. \$50 per month from CMC supports his ministry through donations received for him. **Please pray for Pastor Prin,** his economic needs, his



health, and for new believers to come to faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God.

**II. Christian Education Ministry:**  
**A) Pastors and leaders training:** Please pray for God to re-open the doors for training. Our next training of pastors and leaders is in June 2021. Pray also for the





expenses for each course. The expenses include:

1. Local travel in country for Rev. Radha Manickam and Rev. Paul Goodner.
2. Printing of materials for training in



3. Meals for training classes in three provinces.
4. Room and board in country.

**B) English Class:** The Cambodian Government has closed all schools. They want us to close the CMC center. At the CMC center we have paid teachers. The cost is \$200 monthly. We have 102 students who are studying English in four classes.

**III Church Building Ministry:** CMC Cambodia is raising funds for church building projects and housing for rural families. A complete church building costs \$30,000 and a house \$3,000. Please contact CMC for more detailed information.

**IV. Care Ministry**

**A) Well project Activities:** Please pray for our water-well projects. One well cost \$2,000. Please pray and consider giving the needed funds to help community people obtain clean water.

**Roeun Samnang:** is an orphan receiving \$30 per month from CMC to help with food, materials, and clothes. She is living with her foster grandmother in Siem Reap. She helps to do housework, take care of cows, and cleans up at the CMC center.



**Ching Chang:** is a new student that CMC started to help in September. Chang is receiving \$20 per month from CMC to help



with food, materials, and clothes. He is living with his parents in Siem Reap. He helps to do housework and takes care of his sick father.

a 25-year-old student at Build MBA in Management. Rathana is going to complete her degree program soon after the schools re-open. Her final courses are:
