Cambodian Ministries for Christ, Cambodia Report on Wheelchair For July, 2016

From 17th to 30th of July 2016, CMC national office has donated eleven wheelchairs to the eleven disabilities people are living in the different district in Siem Reap province



1) Mr. Thoeun Nhanh, he is 46 years old, lives with his wife and five children who are the worker and famer, in a small leaf hurts in Bos Krolanh village, Chreav commune, Siem Reap province. Nhanh had an accident by fell from the trees with a height of more than five meters when he is mercenary labor to cut down trees to make money, when he fall on the ground his left leg was fractured and his right leg was sharp and cut by knife to his heel since 2105, he had disability from this situation for over a year, since that he is only stay at home alone without walking to anyway and waiting his wife and other children back from work to help and carry him to outside the house. He is a hopeless men because he cannot help his family to get income, currently, his legs were shrink calf, and he can move himself by

using his hands to moving. Without wheelchair he could not rotation and or moving himself around to bathroom and house.

Mrs. Maan Him, she is 54 years old, a single women living with an old mother and 6 other niece and nephews are the farmers in a small leaf hurts in Vat village, Sae Nouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province. She has had an accident from mine blew up and cutting her right leg in 1983, when she walk into jungle to pick up wild fruits, Plucked Coast and logging to sell in to market for money to feeding her family, she is using wooden crutches made by herself to walk around house and sometime to market, the wooden crutches it unable for her to using this kind, it is difficult to walk for a long way, because it is not standard crutches made. Without wheelchair that can help her to move around her house, market and it also can reduced her painful from using wooden crutches with arm.



Ms. Chea Kunthea, she is 29 years old, a third daughter living with



parents and 3 other brothers and sister are the farmers in Prey Khnol village, Sae Nouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province. Kunthea is a person who had spinal curvature from the time she was born, from waist to both legs were flaccid paralysis, unable to stand or walk like normal people, cannot even walk by her pelvis or arms by herself, her brothers or sister have to carry her all the time she want to moving even to bathroom. It's difficult for her, who needs a wheelchair that easily to more around the house and or visit other relative and bathroom without people carry her.

Mr. Chek Norm, he is 50 years old, living with his wife and 2 children who are the farmers in Sae Nouy village,

province. Norm is a government soldier, in 1987 he was step on a mine during his fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, suddenly a mine was blew up cut his right leg, and other part of his body and left leg is also injured and crippled by shrapnel of mine, he is unable to walk well because his leg is always hurt and had ulcers. Norm never has chance to walk by himself to anywhere far from his home without someone from his family help to carry him or using wooden crutches made by himself. The wheelchair can help him more easily to move around his house, visiting his relative and help his family planting around.



Mrs. Sin Noun, she is 64 years old, living with her husband and 4 children who are the farmers in Vat village, Sae Nouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province. She has had an



accident from mine blew up and cutting her right leg in 1983, when she walk into jungle to pick up wild fruits, Plucked Coast and logging to sell in to market for money to feeding her family, she is using wooden crutches made by herself to walk around house and sometime to market, the wooden crutches it unable for her to using this kind, it is difficult for her to walk for a long way, because it is not standard crutches made. Without wheelchair that can help her to move around her house, market and it also can reduced her painful from using wooden crutches with arm.

6) Mr. Oeun Nang, he is 62 years old, living with his wife and other 3 children who are the farmers in Vat village, Sae Nouy commune, Varin

district, Siem Reap province. Nang is a government soldier, in 1983 he was step on a mine during his fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, suddenly a mine was blew up cut his left leg, and other part of his body and right leg is also injured by shrapnel of mine, he is unable to walk well because his other leg is always hurt and had ulcers also. Nang never has





7) Mr. Chab Lor, he is 67 years old, a widower living with his 4 children are the farmers in Sae Nouy village, Sae Nouy commune, Varit district, Siem Reap province. Lor is a government soldier, in 1984 he was step on a mine during his fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, suddenly a mine was blew up cut his left leg, and other part of his body and right leg is also injured by shrapnel of mine, he is unable to walk well because his other leg is always hurt and had ulcers also. Lor never has chance to walk by himself to anywhere far from his home without someone from his family help to carry him or using wooden artificial limbs made by

himself. The wheelchair can help him more easily to move around his house, visit his relative and help family for planting around.

8) Mr. Pich Poeun, he is 54 years old, a widower living with his 4 children who are the farmers in Vat village, Sae Nouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province. Poeun is a government soldier, in 1990 he was step on a mine during his fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, suddenly a mine was blew up cut both of his legs, and other part of his body also injured by shrapnel of mine, he is unable to walk because some part of his both legs is hurt and had ulcers. Lor never has chance to walk by himself to anywhere far from his home without someone from his family help to carry him or using wooden artificial limbs. The wheelchair can help him



more easily to move around his house, visiting his relative and help his family planting around.



9) Mr. Chan Thai, he is 70 years old, a widower living with his 5 children are the farmers in Vat village, Sae Nouy commune, Varit district, Siem Reap province. Thai is a government soldier, in 1985 he was step on a mine during his fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, suddenly a mine was blew up cut his right both leg, and other part of his body with the other left leg also injured by shrapnel of mine, he is unable to walk well because his other leg is always hurt, some of shrapnel of mine still in. Thai never has chance to walk to anywhere far from his home, he is using wooden artificial limbs made by himself. The wheelchair can help him more easily to move around even his house, visiting his relative and help his children for planting around.

10) Mr. Toeur Ol, he is 46 years old, living with his wife and 5 children are the farmers in a small leaf hurts in Sae Nouy village, Sae Nouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province. He has had an accident from mine blew up and cutting her right leg in 1985, when he walk into jungle to pick up wild fruits, Plucked Coast and logging to sell in to market for money to feeding his family, currently he is using wooden crutches made by himself to walk around house and sometime to market, its unable for him to use, it is difficult to walk because this kind is not the standard of crutches, also other left leg is injured by shrapnel of mine, this mean that his both legs not able to walk well. Without wheelchair that can help him to move around



his house, market and it is reduced his painful from using wooden crutches with arm every time.



11) Mr. Dy Choeuk, he is 48 years old, living with wife and 2 children are the farmer in Sae Nouy village, Sae Nouy commune, Varit district, Seim Reap province. Choeuk is a government soldier, in 1988 he was step on a mine during his fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, suddenly a mine was blew up cut his left leg, and other part of his body with the other right leg also injured by shrapnel of mine, he is unable to walk well because his other leg is always hurt because some of shrapnel of mine is still in it. Choeuk never has chance to walk to any way farm from his home because he is using artificial limbs made from wood by himself. The wheelchair can help him more easily to move around even his house and visiting his relative

also help his wife and children for planting around.
