## Report on Wheelchair

### For July, 2016

From 4<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> of July 2016, CMC national office has donated twenty wheelchairs to the Twenty-One disabilities people are living in the different district in Siem Reap and Odor Meanchay province they all

1) Mrs. Seng Hang, she is 72 years old and lives with her single daughter, who is a primary school teacher, living in Wat Bo village, Salakam Roek commune, Siem Reap province. From the time that she had a car accident running over, she had disability from this situation for nearly three years, only stay at home alone without walking to anyway and waiting her daughter back from work to help and carry her to sit in outside the house. She is a hopeless since the time of her accident, her both pyelography and kneecaps was broken. Without wheelchair she could not rotation and or moving herself without needed someone help and carry her around to bathroom all the time, this is because of her disability a state of her both



pyelography and kneecaps broken and really need this wheelchair.



2) Mr. Saat Yeoum, he is 66 years old live with his three children, they are the farmer, living in a small leaf huts at Srae Nouy village, Srae Nouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province. In 2011, Yoeum, walked into jungle to find wood, vines and pick up some fruits from jungle to sell to market. Misfortunate he step on the mind left from the war and blows up take off his leg from that time. Yoeum has never had chance to move around by himself to anyway without someone help and or carry him to walk with the rest leg. Without wheelchair he could not rotation and or moving himself around to bathroom and other place, he is really happy to have this wheelchair to carry himself around.

3) Mr. Sou Sokha, he is 51 years old, living with his wife and four children in a small leaf huts, eight members in family in Wat village, Srae Nouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province. In 1998, Sokha, is one in a team of de-miners, who help to demining from the field of battle, suddenly one of the mine was blew up by his side, half body of him seriously injured, his left hand cannot move and two of his lags cannot walk any more from the time. For nearly eighteen years, Sokha stay at home alone without walking and waiting until his family members back from work help to carry him to sit in outside the house. He has a hopeless since



the time he has accident. He could not rotate or moving himself without wheelchair or someone help to carry him around to bathroom and somewhere, because of his disability state of his both lags from mine accident.



4) Mrs. Yen Proeng, she is 50 years old, a widow woman living with her single son and two grandchildren in Wat village, Srae Nouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province. She has severe diabetes since 2000 and leg was struck of this situation cannot leave with this. Currently, she cannot walk with the rest leg because it is incurable and face cut. Now she moving up and down because of the accent from her

son and grandchildren when they are available at home, when they are not at home she met a difficultly to moving alone, including going to the bathroom and getting food to eat.

5) Mr. Eam Marn, he is 46 years old, living in a small leaf huts with his four children and wife, his family is a farmer at Ta Dev village, Tav commune, Anlong Veng district, Udor Meanchey province. Marn is a



government soldier, in 1994 he step on mine during fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, a mine was blew up cut of his right leg from that time. Marn never has chance to walk by himself any way from that time, he make a wooden stick by himself help to walk with the other rest of left leg, sometime is really hurt and painful because of the rest leg is also injured.



6) Mr. Meas Sok, he is 63 years old, living with his six children and wife, his family is a farmer at Cheoung Phnom village, Tropaing Prey commune, Anlong Veng district, Udor Meanchey province. Sok is a government soldier, in 1984 he step on mine during fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, a mine was blew up cut his left leg from that time. Sok never has chance to walk by himself any way from that time, he make a wooden stick by himself help to walk with the other rest of right leg,

sometime is really hurt and painful because of the rest leg is also injured.

7) Mr. Kong Koun, he is 54 years old, living with his four children and wife, his family is a farmer at Tropaing Laheak village, Tropaing Prasat commune, Tropaing Prasat district, Udor Meanchey province. Koun is a government soldier, in 1992 he step on mine during fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, a mine was blew up cut his right leg from that time. Koun, never has chance to walk by himself any way from that time. Without wheelchair he could not rotation and or moving himself without someone help and carry him around to bathroom all the time.



8) Mrs. Ly Chandavy, she is 34 years old, a widow woman living with three children and a younger brother in Veal village, Kok Chork commune, Siem Reap province. Three of her children are the students at primary school in Siem Reap and her younger brother is a taxi driver at Angkor temple. Chandavy is an embroidered clothing in Siem Reap City, the small income from her business is support for her children's school fee and some other need for her family need. She had a disability since she was born and is paralyzed from the waist to toe. Since her husband was devoiced with her only has to stay at home alone with this conditions to do her job as embroidered clothing to earn some money help to feed her children and at home, she stay at home and waiting for her children

back from school to help for cook food because she cannot walk to cook.

9) Mr. Eich Phirum, he is 62 years old, he is a widowers is living with six children in Phnoa village, Tasous commune, Svay Chrum district, Svay Rieng province, some of his children are the farmers and some of them are working in factory. In 1975 during the Khmer Rouge regime, Phirum was illness and go to stay at hospital which is no doctor or specialist treatment medication. Unnamed vaccines and proper guidance to use when injection, they injected him with no technical and now he lost his legs cannot move from the waist to toe. Currently he is sitting and sleeping on a hard bed waiting for his children from the field and work to help his rotation.



10) Mrs. Tharn Kunthear, she is 36 years old, Kunthear is living with an old farther 74 years old, her husband 47 years old an officer of Agricultural provincial department, and a high school child 17 year old, in Krus village, Svay Dankum commune, Siem Reap province. She was diagnosed of her body nerve problem, this caused by the negligence of the doctor's surgery. After surgery, a year later, she was paralyzed all the of her body nerves and the nervous system may not intellect Sometimes she was unwittingly when foot asteroid or urinating, she had ulcers from waist to toe, and her both legs was shrink. She cannot move or stand without someone to help her to walk.

Without wheelchair she is sitting and laying on the bed and sometimes an old father's servant her food and drink.





11) Mr. Threan Phan, he is 54 years old, Phan is living with his wife and a son 11 years old student in a small leaf huts in Mondul three village, Slor Kram commune Siem Reap province. Phan is a government soldier, in 1993 he was injured by explosion of grenade in battlefields during fighting with enemies, all part of his body and legs were injured by shrapnel of grenade, both of his eyes were blinded since that. Currently his is beggar in the area of Angkor temple, he is unable to walk because of his both legs were injured and hurting from this situation. Without the wheelchair he meet the difficult to moving around for his life because he need his kid to lead him to walk with difficulty, both of his legs is crippled and broken knees. Without help from people Phan cannot walk or stand he only lay on the bed or sitting again to the wall waiting family member return home to help him, although go to bathroom.

12) Mr. Seng Ra, he is 44 years old, Ra is living with his wife and six of his children are the student, in a small leaf huts in Mondul three village, Slor Kram commune Siem Reap province. Ra is a government soldier, in 1993 he was injured by a stepped on mine and blew up cut his right leg in battlefields during his fighting with enemies, his left leg is crippled by injured of shrapnel of mine, he unable to walk well because of his two legs is always hurt and had ulcers. Sometime he need to take off his artificial leg due to it hurt and ulcers on it. Without wheelchair to help him to move around in sometime for the need beside of his artificial leg.



13) Ms. Samrith Sophron, she is 6 years old, living with her parents, they are the famer in Rolumrun village, Sraenouy commune, Varin district, Siem Reap province, Sophron is a one of three siblings with disabilities as her, they has had the diseases since they were born in this poor family and could not walk, both of their feet are weak and unable to stand or walk, they cannot run and playing with the children around village by their hips, not only in house, as well as on the ground.

14) Mr. Van Theng, he is 44 years old, living with his wife and two children in Mondul three village, Slor Kram commune Siem Reap province. Theng is a government soldier, in 1990 he was injured by a stepped on mine blew up cut his right leg in battlefields during fighting with enemies, some part of his body and other left leg are injured by shrapnel of mine. Sometime he want to walk to help his wife and children at rice field and planting around his house, but his two legs are always hurt and had ulcers, it is difficult to use crutches. Without wheelchair to help him to move around the house and help his wife at rice field as well.



15) Mrs. Sin Ho, she is 57 years old, a widow living with her 6 years old son in Tadave village, Tropaing Trav commune, Anlong Veng district, Odor Meanchay province. In last five years ago she fell from the tree height of 5m below and had fractures her waist, after her husband had died she had to get premium and responsible to support her young son just one year old by that time, to claim up the trees to pick up wild fruits and leafs to sell to market for some money to support her child. Since then, she could not be treated up that make her paralyzed from the waist down to the both legs, it is hardest for her went on crutches every day

for the hardest Hold

16) Ms. Kang Phallek, she is 31 years old, living with parents, brother and sister in Porbanteay Chay village, Siem Reap province. Phallek is a person who had spinal curvature from the time she was born, from her waist to both legs were flaccid paralysis, making her unable to stand or walk like



normal people, she is walking by her pelvis and arms is can help herself to move forward. It's difficult for her, who needs a wheelchair easily to travel around the house and to visit other relative without need people to help and carry her.



17) Mr. Pin Poeun, he is 64 years old, living with his wife and five children in Tadave village, Tropaing Trav commune, Anlong Veng district, Odor Meanchay province. Poeun is a government soldier, in 1988 he was injured by a stepped on mine blew up cut his left leg in battlefields during fighting with enemies, some part of his body and other left leg are injured by shrapnel of mine. Sometime he want to walk to help his wife and children at rice field and planting around his house, but it is always hurt and had ulcers on the sure face, it is difficult to use crutches. Without wheelchair to help him to move round the house and help his wife at rice field as well.

18) Mr. Kveang Heng, he is 62 years old, living with his wife and six children in Trapaing Cess village, Kok Chork commune, Siem Reap province. Heng is a government soldier, in 1987 he was injured by a stepped on mine and blew up cut his left leg in battlefields during fighting with enemies, some other part of his right leg, body are injured by shrapnel of mine. Currently his is beggar in the area of Angkor temple, beside of his begging sometime he want to walk to help his wife and children at rice field and planting around his house, but his two legs is always hurt and difficult to walk by use crutches. Without wheelchair he cannot moving around the house help his wife at rice field as well, it is also for his walk at temple for money begging.



19) Mr. Vat Soklay, he is 28 years old, living with his wife and two children in Tropaing village, Kantek commune, Prasth Bakorng district, Siem Reap province. Soklay, had a car accident in 2007, was run over, hit and caused his left leg and broke his both hips pyelography, he could not walk from the time until to this day. Currently his a performer arts of disabilities group in Siem Reap for money. Without the wheelchair he will meet the difficult to moving around for his life to help his family.



Both her legs were tied with a plastic sheet to hold her stand. She was walking by clinging to the walls and the other things near to walk. Sreynay,

20) Ms. Mia Sreynay, she is 23 years old, she is living with a widow father 87 years old and three of other brother and sisters. When she was a baby she has high fiver disease, and continued through both her legs were paralyzed from the knees down below. Currently is a tailors at her village, this business can help to get income to help her family. Without the wheelchair she will meet the difficult to moving around for her life to help her family.



21) Mr. Voeun Voeth, he is 52 years old, living with his wife and five children in Salakam Roek village, Slokram commune, Siem Reap province. Voeth, is a government soldier, in 1988 he was injured by blew of grenade in battlefields during fighting with enemies, all part of his body and legs were injured by shrapnel of grenade, both of his eyes were blinded since that. Currently his is beggar in the area of Angkor temple, he is unable to walk because of his both legs were injured and hurting from this situation. Without the wheelchair he meet the difficult to moving around for his life because he need his kid to lead him to walk with difficultly.
