

Cambodian Ministries for Christ Cambodia Report on Wheelchair For August and September, 2016

From August to September 2016, CMC national office has donated seven wheelchairs to the seven disabilities people are living in the different district and provinces

1) Mr. Chhun Saray, he is 56 years old, lives with his wife and four children are the worker and famers in a small leaf hurts in Pouy Khdoeung village, Praeneth Praeh commune, Praeneth Praeh district, Banteay Meanchey province. Saray is a government soldier, in 1992 he was step on a mine during his fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, suddenly a mine was blew up cut both of his legs, other part of his body also injured by shrapnel of mine, he is unable to walk because of his both legs is hurt. Saray never has chance to walk by himself to anywhere far from his home without someone from his family help to carry him or using artificial limbs. The wheelchair can help him more easily to move around his house, visiting his



relative around village and help his family planting around.



2) Mrs. Kao Yung, she is 82 years old, living with her single son in Trokeat village, Trapaing Kong commune, Samrong Tong district, Kampong Speu province. Currently her son is a Police officer in Kampong Speu provincial. Yung had a high blood presser and stroke after that doctor found some part of her brain artery has blood clots, doctor cannot be treated her since 2010. From the time that she had high blood pressure and disability to move is nearly six years, she is only stay at home, the rest of her is on the bed all the time. Since she was diseases of high blood pressure she could not moving herself without someone helping to carry her around to bathroom all the time, until her son back from work. There is only the wheelchair can help her and let her sit

outside her bedroom seeing people around her and get fresh air.

3) Mr. Som Kim Khorn, he is 82 years old, a single men no family living with monks in pagoda, in Khbal Koh village, Koh Khsach Chunlea commune, Saang district, Kandal province. Kim Khorn is an old age men living in pagoda with monks, without someone from his family to take care him, due to his kids are living far away from him, some of them are married and they stay and working in Thailand as a worker there. Kim Khorn life's living in difficult condition he always lay on bed without sitting, he can sit in sometime by predicated his back into the wall, if no someone help to carry him to sit then he has had no chance to sit up, even his both arms and legs are really weak cannot moving. Currently his life living in pagoda by giving food and drink from monks and disciples of monks. The wheelchair of Hope can help him more easily to move around the cottage, visiting other around pagoda and sitting outside to have fresh air instead laying on bed all the time.



4) Mr. Varn Sovann, he is 54 years old, living with his wife and three other children are the farmers in Andong Teok village, Lom Hach commune, Angsnuol district, Kanal province. Sovann is a government soldier, in 1987 he was step on a mine during his fighting with Khmer Rouge in battlefields, suddenly a mine was blew up cut off a part of his feet, both of his legs from bottom up were injured by shrapnel mines. Over last ten years ago, Sovann can see and walked a bit to somewhere around his house and neighbors nearby, both of his eyes can seeing in good condition. Now his two legs no longer walk and or moving to anywhere even around his house or to bathroom, his both eyes become blinds. This hopeless men from his condition is always sitting and laying on the wooden bed at home alone, waiting his wife and children returned from the field and help to moves him around and to bathroom. The wheelchair of

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hope can help his family more easily to moving or carry him to bathroom and bring him visiting around villager and get fresh air instead of sitting on bed inside house.

5) Mrs. Meak Chan, she is 80 years old, a widow woman living with her six children are the farmers and two grandchildren are students in a small leaf hurt in Prey Tup village, Sro Gner commune, Traing district, Takeo province. Chann, had a high blood presser and stroke after that doctor found that some part of her artery has blood clots and cut, doctor cannot be treated her since 2012. From the time that she had high blood pressure and disability to move is nearly five years, she is only stay at home sometime alone and sometime with her grandchildren, sitting and laying on the bed all the time. Since she was diseases from high blood pressure she could not moving herself without someone helping to carry her around to bathroom and sitting to get fresh air outside her house, she has to waiting on her bed inside the room until her children returned back from work and or from rice field to carry her to sitting front outside of her house to get fresh air. There is only the wheelchair of hope that can help her children and grandchildren more easily to carry her to sit outside bedroom seeing people around her and can go to visiting her neighbors from house to house instead of staying on bed in bedroom all the time.



6) Mrs. Loy Yun, she is 50 years old, a widow woman living with her two children they are the construction worker and two other grandchildren are the primary school students in Keteyos village, Prey Chrouk commune, Pouk district, Siem Reap province. Yun has had high blood pressure in more than ten years ago. The doctors say that her condition cannot be heal. Since then, her condition began to paralysis her left side body that cannot move her leg and arm, even of speaking she is cannot speak. Currently, before her children go to work, they have to carry her to sit in a hammock in front of the house looking and playing around with her grandchildren while they are circulated their schedule to going to school because they wanting to have someone at home with her. There is only wheelchair of hope can help herself children easily bring her to sit on wheelchair moving around the house by somebody else can pull the wheelchair from place to place including to bathroom and visiting her neighbor around village.



7) Mrs. Kim Ly, she is 70 years old, a widow woman living with her couple children are the farmers and other three grandchildren are the primary school students in Toul Roveang village, Toul Roveang commune, Pouk district, Siem Reap province. Ly has had high blood pressure since 2011. The doctors say that her condition cannot be heal. Then, from time to time her condition began to paralysis her body both her arms and legs cannot moving, even of speaking she cannot speak. Currently, she is only stay at home sometime alone and sometime with her grandchildren, sitting and laying on the bed all the time. Since she was diseases from high blood pressure she could not moving herself without someone helping to carry her around to bathroom and sitting to get fresh air outside her house, she has waiting on her bed inside the room until her children returned back from rice field to carry her to sitting outside in front of her house to get fresh air. There is only the wheelchair of hope that can help her children and her grandchildren can carry her more easily to sitting outside her bedroom seeing people around visiting her neighbor instead of staying on bed in bedroom all the time.
