Church Relation Ministry:

Pastor Support: CMC Cambodia provides partial support for eleven pastors in four provinces. They serve their own churches and other villages with good results. The financial support helps the pastors with their daily expenses during their travel to cell churches. It also helps them operate in other Christian ministries in targeted areas.



A) Food relief Activities:


Please pray for Cambodian Ministries for Christ to obtain funds to help poor people, pastors, and leaders who need food for their families.
