I thank you for your generous support to help cover the needs of my family and ministries here in Cambodia. I thank the Lord for allowing me to serve him this year. I am looking forward to expanding God's ministry in Cambodia from July to September 2023. I shared the love of God in the local community and in the provinces. Our pastors and our partners have a good relationship with each other. Cambodian Ministries for Christ would like to say thank you to the Churches and the donors for supporting and helping us organize the training programs.

Church Relation Ministry:

Pastor Support: CMC provides partial support for Twelve pastors in four provinces. They serve their own churches and other villages with good results. Financial support helps the pastors with their daily expenses during their travel to cell churches. It also helps them operate in other Christian ministries in targeted areas.

1-Pastor Mam SamOeurn's church has fifty-seven people in attendance



every Sunday. In this quarter **Pastor** Moam Sam Oeurn has had a stroke. He stand cannot and preach at church on Sundays. He assigned his

assistant pastor to travel with another assistant pastor to villages outside his hometown and preach Christ through the bible and leaflets and sharing testimonies of Christian life with non-believers in villages.

Please pray for Pastor SamOeurn Pray for his health, now he has had a serious stroke, he cannot sit or stand and even speaking is not clear. Pray that God will heal him and recover from this stroke. Pray for the new believers to grow in their faith. He receives \$125 per month from CMC for his ministry through donations received for him.



2-Pastor Phan Sophun's church has 218 people in attendance on Sunday. He preaches at nine services every



Sunday with his assistant pastors and leaders. Pastor Sophun visits cell-churches, teaching leaders and church members. Twenty-Three

leaders have been trained in the book, "Living Life Pray to Jesus and Bible doctrine". He preaches the gospel of Jesus Christ through leaflets and



Christian testimonies to non-believers in villages outside of his area around Twenty-Five people in attendance. Thirty-Five people believed in Jesus as their savior in this quarter. Please pray for the new people who have trusted Jesus as their Savior. The new believers



are attending different church locations near their homes. He receives \$200 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

Please pray for Pastor Sophun to have enough funds to complete his church building. The building is about 95% completed. Pray for enough funds to extend new kindergarten classes. Pray for health for himself and the new believer's spiritual growth.

3-Pastor Tong Vanny's church has 25 people in attendance on Sunday. Pastor Vanny preaches at his cell church every weekend. He preaches the gospel of

4-Pastor Cheam Rin: Pastor Cheam Rin's church has One hundred and six people in attendance on Sunday. He oversees Ten services every Sunday with his assistant pastors. Pastor Rin

and his wife travel to villages and schools outside of their hometown to share the love of God. He preaches the good news of salvation in Jesus to around Forty-Five people in attendance. Nine people believed in Jesus as their Savior this quarter. Please pray for the new people who have trusted Jesus as their Savior to grow in their faith in Jesus. The new believers attend churches near their homes.



Pastor Rin and his wife attend a monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. They travel to a group of churches to teach the Bible. He teaches what he has learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. Twelve leaders have been trained using the book, "Living in Christ model". Pastor Rin and his wife visit and pray for church families, including having Bible study with them. Praise God for using him to bless people.

Please pray for Pastor Cheam Rin's economic needs, his wife health, for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He receives \$100 per month from CMC which supports his ministry.

They teach what they have learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. Four leaders



have been trained with the book, "Gift from God". Praise God for using him to bless people.

Please pray for Pastor Bai, his economic needs, his health, and for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He receives \$125 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

6-Pastor Hun Saret's church has fifty-seven people in attendance on Sunday.



Pastor Saret and his pastor visits cell-churches and teach leaders in churches as well as members and outside of their hometown to share the love

of God. He preaches the good news of salvation in Jesus with around seventeen people in attendance. Five people believed in Jesus as their savior, and five of them were baptized this quarter. Please pray for the new people who have trusted Jesus as their Savior

and grow in their faith in Jesus. The new believers are attending different church locations near their homes. This makes it easy for them to attend the main church every Sunday. He and his



pastor preach at Four services every Sunday. Pastor Saret attends a monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. He and his pastor travel to a group of churches to teach the Bible. They teach what they have learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. Four new leaders using the book, "Jesus is the Light on the World". Praise God for using him to bless people.

Please pray for Pastor Saret, his economic needs, his health, for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He



receives \$50 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

7-Pastor Prom Prin's church has fiftyseven people in attendance every



Sunday. He travels with another assistant pastor to other villages outside of his hometown and preaches Christ through bible leaflets and

sharing testimonies of Christian life with non-believers in villages. He preaches God's Word and shares the gospel of Jesus with around three

people in attendance. This includes a Christian wedding, other ceremonies as well as a funeral. Sixteen people have believed in Jesus as their Savior. Please pray for the new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus. The new believers are attending different church locations near their homes. Pastor Prin preaches at three services every Sunday with



another assistant pastor. Two leaders have been trained in "evangelism and discipleship". Pastor Prin attends a monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. He and another pastor travel to a group to teach what they have learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes.

Please pray for Pastor Prin, his economic needs, his health, for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He receives \$125 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

8-Pastor Bo Soa's church has Eightyone people in attendance on Sunday. He



preaches at three services every Sunday with his assistant pastor. Pastor Soa and his assistant pastor visit cell-churches

and teach leaders and church members providing training to 350 people about community development and agriculture. In addition, he had worship services with them including sharing the Gospel of Jesus. As well as a Christian funeral and other ceremonies.



God wants him to share with them about Christ and disciple them as a pastor. God wants him to teach them about Christ and His salvation, as well as the Word of God and how to do what it says. Ten people believed in



Jesus as their savior in this quarter and six people have been baptized. The new believers are attending different church locations near their homes. This makes it easy for them to attend the main church every Sunday. Pastor Soa attends a monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. He travels to a group of churches to teach the Bible. They teach what they have learned Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. Eight leaders have been trained on "Basic Christian Doctrine and how to share the gospel" to unbelievers. Praise God for using him to bless people.

Please pray for Pastor Soa, his economic needs, his health, and for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He receives \$100 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

9-Pastor Kong Sokhorn's church has One Hundred people in attendance on

preach the good news of salvation in Jesus to everyone with around Seventy people in attendance. Ten people have believed in Jesus as their Savior. Fifteen people have been baptized. One new cell-church has been formed to a





total Fifteen people in attending. The new believers attend churches near their homes. He preaches at five services every Sunday with his assistant pastor. Pastor Sokhorn attends monthly church committee meetings with other churches and pastors from different locations in the provinces via Zoom



meetings and sometimes face-to- face. Once per month he conducts pastors' conferences and training with the TEE (Theological Education by Extension) and Church Missions at his main church and other cell-churches. Around Ninety-five leaders and Pastors have been trained. Praise God for using him to bless people.

Please pray for Pastor Kong Sokhorn's economic needs, his health, and for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He receives \$200 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

10-Pastor Heng Vorakveasna's church has Eight hundred people in



attendance on Sunday. Pastor Veasna has much contact with many unbelievers. God helps him and his church by using ZOOM and Telegram to keep in touch with church members, and to be able to share the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ with Cambodian people who are living in the country. He shared the love of God with



Cambodians in his community and others. He leads the three services at the main church every Sunday with his Pastor. He leads the Young Visionary (Y.V.) group weekly and has a Sunday



School class, bible discussion, sharing testimony, and praying together with the (Y.V.) group. Veasna has coordinated and leads the Cambodian Christian a group of Youth, women, and Leaders Conference and a celebration for the 50th Anniversary of Rev. Taing Vek Huong and his



marriage as well as their service to reach Cambodia for Christ in August at Phnom Penh New Life Church with a thousand people attended. A group of pastors of New Life provincial churches gathered at the New Life church in Phnom Penh to evaluate the ministry and pray together for the growth of New Life Provincial Churches and health with self-support. Veasna had a trip to Kampot province among Weekly Evangelical Club's (WEC) members to encourage and strengthen each member to keep moving, sharing Christ as the way of life. He meets with a group called, Young Visionary, to evaluate and to pray for GOD's grace and favor to grow the Young Visionary group, every 2nd week of the month. The Young Visionary Groups have fellowship and meet with Rev. Taing Vek Huong of the New Life Churches. They receive advice and encouragement on how to live wisely and reach their friends and families for Christ, to strengthen their relationships with one another and encourage them to keep loving God and serving God through the Young

Visionary group that God has entrusted to them.

Please pray for Pastor Veasna's economic needs, his health, for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and to find the right school for his son. He receives \$200 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

11-Pastor San Chamrong's church



has Twenty-Five people in attendance on Sunday. Pastor Chamrong visits a cell-church, teaching new believers, church members and outside of their hometown to share the love of God. He preaches the good news of salvation in



Jesus to everyone with around Fifteen people in attendance. Pastor Chamrong serves at two church services every Sunday, one service in the morning



from 9:30am to 10:30am, that church is named, People Center for Leaning (PCL) Christian NGO's Church. He serves at another service in the afternoon and preaches and serves as a pastor from 1:30pm to 2:30pm at the CMC center to a total of 25 people in attendance. Besides Bible training and church services Pastor Chamrong,



attends monthly church committee meetings with the other churches and pastors from around Siem Reap provinces via Zoom meetings and face to face. Every week he and his wife travel to visit church members to pray for their health and families and conduct the Bible teaching to children and youth. They teach what they have learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other conference and classes, as well as he, his wife and pastors travel as a group visiting and share the Gospel to villagers and to unbelievers. Praise God for using him to bless people.

Please pray for Pastor Chamrong, his economic needs, his health, and for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He receives \$200 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

II. Christian Education Ministry:

A) Pastor and leader training: Cambodian Ministries for Christ is going to organize and continue the training classes for Pastors and Leaders in the three difference provinces (Siem Reap, Battambang and Kampot Province from this October to November. The training is continuing the book of "New Testament Survey



and Preaching Biblical Massages and Pastoral Ministry" in Siem Reap, "Bible Doctrine Survey" in Battambang and "Old Testament Survey" for Chhuk, Kampot province.



We are very grateful to GOD for this opportunity to continue and organize the Pastors and Leaders training. Please pray for the coming training for pastors and leaders, pray and contribute to equip our pastors and leaders in Cambodia so they will be able to win souls for Christ. We are thankful for the Lord reminding us to "Stay humble and live simple" serving. May God keep

His servants staying faithful until their last breath. We at CMC are very grateful to our Lord Jesus Christ for his mercy and favor in using us and blessing our ministry. We also would like to say thank you very much to



donors and Churches who have supported the needs of these trainings.

B) Partner and Work. Glory be to our

God, in August-September, Cambodian Ministries for Christ is very grateful to God for an opportunity host a visitor donor from the United States to visit Pastors and churches that CMC partner and working with them. Our visitor was very happy to see the churches and their ministries growing in God.

Cambodian Ministries for Christ has donated a motor bike to Pastor Khoem Bia for his transportation so that he can go from place to place for church ministries and sharing Gospel with villagers.

C) English Classes Praise God that CMC center has continued the English classes. The two classes start at 4:30-7:30pm in the evening with a total of Twenty students attending two classes. At the CMC center we have paid teachers. The cost is \$150 per month. Pray that we have enough funds to pay



those teachers.

D) Project Sewing: Since the beginning of August, Cambodian Ministries for Christ has resumed a sewing project for nine poor ladies living around the Cambodian Ministries for Christ center, which will last three months. After completing this Cambodian sewing course, our

Ministries for Christ will provide one sewing machine for each person to earn money through tailoring for their daily living and family needs.

III. Church Building Ministry: CMC Cambodia is raising funds for church building projects and housing for rural families. A complete church building



costs \$30,000 and a house \$3,000. Please contact CMC for more detailed information.

Every Sunday at CMC center we have a Church Service led by Pastor Chamrong with 25 people attending the service.

IV. Care Ministry:

A) Food relief Activities: Please pray for Cambodian Ministries for Christ to obtain funds to help poor people for food project needs.



B) Well Project Activities: Please pray for Cambodian Ministries for Christ to obtain funds to help poor people for water-well projects in their communities. There is a real need for clean water in remote areas. One well cost \$2,000. Please pray and consider giving funds to help people obtain clean water.

C) Student Support:

Roeun Samnang: Is an orphan



receiving \$30 per month from CMC to help with food, materials, and clothes. She is living with her foster

grandmother in Siem Reap. She helps to do housework, takes care of cows, and cleans up at the CMC Center.

Ching Chang: Is a one student that CMC helps. Chang is receiving \$35 per month from CMC to help with food, materials, and clothes. He is living with

his parents in Siem Reap. He helps to do housework and takes care of his sick



father. Chang

Chang and his family. Chang has worked hard to earn money after school to help his family, this is because of his father's illness, and for his family's economic needs.

Manickam Rama is a 33-year-old student, he is a new student who gets a



scholarship for annual \$600 from CMC for his three and half years of tuition fees to study. He is studying in first

year at Build Bright University (BBU), in the field of Information Technology for a bachelor's degree certificate. He studies from Monday-Friday in the evening from 6:00p.m-9:00 p.m. He had done the Mid-term examination of



Graphic Design and got the result of 94/100 and Quiz 85/100. Besides his study, Rama also is the Administrator at CMC Center in Siem Reap. He has a job to do every day of the week. The work includes the office and around the center, taking care of the facilities and the building. He supervises the gardeners and cleaners. Sometimes repairing broken plumbing or electrical. In addition, at night he has to look after the security around the whole CMC center. Sometimes he also helps to look after livestock and trees, preparing the monthly salaries for the staff at CMC. Rama also teaches an English class at the CMC center for a high level of

students, he teaches from Monday to Friday each week.
