Church Relation Ministry:

Pastor Support: CMC provides partial support for Twelve pastors in four provinces. They serve their own churches and other villages with good results. Financial support helps the pastors with their daily expenses during their travel to cell churches. It also helps them operate in other Christian ministries in targeted areas.

ceremonies, as well as a funeral. Please pray for Eighteen people who accepted Christ and five of them were baptized. These new people have trusted Jesus as their Savior. The new believers are attending different church locations near their homes. Five leaders have been trained in evangelism and discipleship. Pastor SamOeun attends a



monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces.

Please pray for Pastor SamOeurn Pray for good health for him as he is now recovering from his stroke. Pray for the new believers to grow in their faith. He receives \$125 per month from CMC for his ministry through donations received for him.

2-Pastor Phan Sophun's church has 130 people in attendance on Sunday.



He preaches at nine services every Sunday with his assistant pastors and

leaders and church members. Twenty-Three leaders have been trained in the book, "Living Life Pray to Jesus". He preaches the gospel of Jesus Christ





He preaches the good news of salvation in Jesus to everyone, with around Sixteen people in attendance. This quarter Eight people have believed in Jesus as their Savior, and Six were baptized. Please pray for new people who have trusted Jesus as their Savior. The new believers are



attending different cell-churches near their homes. This makes it easy for them to attend the main church every Sunday. He and his assistant pastor preaches at four services every Sunday. Pastor Bai attends a monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. He and his assistant pastor travel to group of churches to teach the Bible. They teach what they



have learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. Four leaders have been trained with the book, "love God and Sharing Good News". Praise God for using him to bless people.

assistant pastor visits cell-churches teaching leaders and church members and providing training to 320 people about community development and agriculture. In addition, he had worship services with them including sharing



the Gospel of Jesus. As well as a Christian funeral and other ceremonies. God wants him to share with them about Christ and disciple them as a pastor. God wants him to teach them about Christ and His salvation, as well as the Word of God and how to do



what it says. Fifteen people believed in Jesus as their savior in this quarter and fifteen people have been baptized. The new believers are attending different church locations near their homes. This makes it easy for them to attend the main church every Sunday. Pastor Soa attends a monthly committee meeting with pastors from four different provinces. He travels to a group of churches to teach the Bible. They teach what they have learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. Six leaders have been trained on Basic Christian Doctrine and how to share the gospel to unbelievers. Praise God for using him to bless people.

Please pray for Pastor Soa, his economic needs, his health, and for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He receives \$100 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

9-Pastor Kong Sokhorn's church has Ninety-five people in attendance on



Sunday. Pastor Sokhorn and assistant pastors travels to villages and schools outside of his hometown to share the love of God. They

preach the good news of salvation in Jesus to everyone with around Forty people in attendance. Seven people have believed in Jesus as their Savior.





The new believers attend churches near their homes. He preaches at five services every Sunday with his assistant pastor. Pastor Sokhorn attends monthly church committee meetings with other churches and pastors from different locations in the provinces via Zoom meetings and sometimes face-to- face. Once per month he conducts pastors' conferences and training with the TEE (Theological Education by Extension) and Church Missions at his main church and other cell-churches to about Ninety-five leaders and Pastors have been trained. Praise God for using him to bless people.

Please pray for Pastor Kong Sokhorn's economic needs, his health, and for new believers to grow in their faith in Jesus, and for wisdom in serving God. He receives \$200 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

10-Pastor Heng Vorakveasna's church has Eight hundred people in

God helps him and his church by using ZOOM and Telegram to keep in touch with church members, and to be able to share the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ with Cambodian people who are living in the country. evaluate the ministry and pray together for the growth of New Life Provincial Churches and health with self-support. The Young Visionary Groups has lunch fellowship and meets with Rev. Taing Vek Huong of the New Life Churches. Thev receive advice encouragement on how to live wisely and reach their friends and families for Christ, to strengthen their relationships with one another and encourage them to keep loving God and serving God through Young Visionary group that God has entrusted to them. grateful to GOD for this opportunity to organize the Pastors and Leaders training. We had a nice time rejoicing and having fellowship together and getting to know each other. We are



thankful for the Lord reminding us to "Stay humble and live simple" serving. May God keep His servants staying faithful until last breath. We at CMC are very grateful to our Lord Jesus Christ for his mercy and favor in using us and blessing our ministry. We also would like to say thank you very much to donors and Churches who have supported the needs of these trainings.

C) English Classes Praise God that CMC center has continued the English classes. The three classes start from 4:30-7:30pm in the evening with a total of Twenty students attending three classes. At the CMC center we have paid teachers. The cost is \$150 per month. Pray that we have enough funds to pay those teachers.

III. Church Building Ministry: CMC Cambodia is raising funds for church building projects and housing for rural families. A complete church building costs \$30,000 and a house \$3,000. Please contact CMC for more detailed information.



Every Sunday at CMC center we have a Service leading by Pastor Chamrong with 15 people attending the service.

helps to do housework, takes care of cows, and cleans up at the CMC Center.

Ching Chang: Is a one student that CMC helps. Chang is receiving \$35 per month from CMC to help with food,



materials, and clothes. He is living with his parents in Siem Reap. He helps to do housework and takes care of

his sick father. Chang is in grade 8. He attends English classes every days after school, including bible study with his pastor. Please pray for Ching Chang, he dropped out of school and went to work to earn money to help his family, this is because of his father's illness, and for his family's economic needs.

Chan Rathana is a 26-year-old student at Build Bright University (BBU).



CMC pays her annual tuition of \$540 for an MBA in Management. She has completed her degree program and graduated from university

this June. Please pray for Cambodian Ministries for Christ to obtain funds continue to help the other poor university students more other in new year.
