Church Relation Ministry

Pastor Support: CMC provides partial support for Thirteen pastors in Five provinces. They serve their own churches and other villages with good results. Financial support helps the pastors with their daily expenses during their travel to cell churches. It also helps them operate in other Christian ministries in targeted areas.

1-Pastor Mam Sam Oeurn's church has fifty-nine people in attendance every Sunday. Please pray for Pastor



Moam Sam Oeurn, he has had a stroke, and that God would heal him to get better. From time to time, he cannot wake up and attend church.

Please keep praying for pastor Sam Ouern to get healed from God. Pastor Moam Sam Oeurn has appointed pastor Bo Sao and Soeum SamAth to be an assistant at his church during this time. His assistant pastors travel with other assistant pastors to villages outside his hometown and preach Christ through the bible and leaflets and sharing testimonies of Christian life with nonbelievers in villages. **Please pray for**



Pastor Sam Oeurn, pray for his health, to recover soon. He now cannot sit and stand even talk. Pray that God will heal him and recover from this condition soon. He receives \$100 per month from CMC for his ministry through donations received for him.

2-Pastor Doeu Rumlong's church has



71 people in attendance on Sunday. He preaches at three services every Sunday. Pastor Rumlong and his wife spends time to visit celladers and church

churches, teaching leaders and church members and pray for them. Five leaders have been trained by using the book of "Faithfulness to God" He preaches the gospel of Jesus Christ



through leaflets and Christian testimonies to non-believers in villages outside in his area, where forty-two people were in attendance. Four people believed in Jesus as their savior this quarter. Please pray for the new people who have trusted Jesus as their Savior. The new believers are attending the new cell church locations near their homes. Pastor Runlong partners with World Vision Organization to provide training to community people using a program of community development and agriculture to build their knowledge of development. Everyday



pastor Rumlong teaches children after school who have a weak knowledge of mathematics and can help to improve their knowledge. In addition, he has worship services with them including sharing the Gospel of Jesus. As well as a Christian funeral and other ceremonies. God wants him to share with them about Christ and disciple them as a pastor. God wants him to teach them about Christ and His salvation, as well as the Word of God and how to do what it says. 200 people including children believed in Jesus as their savior in this quarter. The new believers are attending cell church locations near their homes. This makes



it easy for them to attend the main church every Sunday. Pastor Soa and his team travel to a group of churches and share the gospel and teach the Bible. They teach what they have learned from Cambodian Ministries for Christ and other classes. Eight leaders have been trained on "Basic Christian Doctrine and how to share the gospel" to unbelievers. The new believers are attending the new churches that he has started. He preaches at three services every Sunday. Pastor Sokhorn attends monthly church committee meetings with other churches and pastors from different locations in the provinces. Once per month he conducts pastors'



conferences and training with the TEE (Theological Education by Extension) and Church Missions at his main church and other cell-churches. Sixty leaders and Pastors have been trained with the TEE book and Basic of Christian Faith and Missions. Praise God for using him to bless people. Glory be to our God for this quarter, pastor Sokhorn has completed building four church buildings in the four



different locations, and they had inaugurations in each. people who are living in the country. He shares the love of God with Cambodians in his community and others. He leads the three services at the main church every Sunday with his Senior Pastor Taing Vek Huong. Pastor Veasna and his Senior Pastor Taing Vek Huong leads the Young Visionary (Y.V.) group weekly and has a Sunday School class, bible discussion, sharing testimonies, and praying together with the (Y.V.) group. Pray for GOD's grace and favor to grow the Young Visionary



group, every 2nd week of the month. The Young Visionary Group has fellowship and meets with Rev. Taing Vek Huong of the New Life Churches. They receive advice, encouragement on how to live wisely and reach their friends and families for Christ. They learn to strengthen their relationships with one another and encourage each other to keep loving God and serving through the Young Visionary group that God has entrusted to them. Pastor Veasna has coordinated and leads the Cambodian Christians, a group of Youth, women, and Leaders Conference. 70 pastors and Leaders from the different provinces and churches attended a conference in November. In the grace of God and through the Phnom Penh New Life Mission Church they have a Weekly Evangelism Club that involves his church sharing the Goodnews about



Jesus Christ to one person per week. There are many new believers joining the church and they are having opportunities to nurture their spiritual life with God. They are blessed and the Lord's providing them with knowledge. Glory be to our God, this December, pastor Veasna has celebrated Christmas with a total of 1,466 people attended in his area and rejoiced in the fellowship of believers and unbelievers alike. He receives \$200 per month from CMC which supports his ministry through donations received for him.

B) English Classes CMC center has continued the English classes. The three classes start at 4:30-7:30pm in the evening with a total of Eighteen students attending three classes. At the CMC center we have paid teachers. The cost is \$100 per month. Pray that we have enough funds to pay those teachers.

III. Church Building Ministry

CMC Cambodia is raising funds for church building projects and housing for rural families. A complete church building costs \$30,000 and a house \$3,900. Please contact CMC for more detailed information.



Every Sunday at CMC center we have a Church Service led by Pastor Ravy Manickam with 15 people attending the service.

IV. Care Ministry

A) Food relief Activities: Cambodian Ministries for Christ is raising funds to help for food distribution to family's needs. Each family need for food spending is \$35 per family.

Please pray for Cambodian Ministries for Christ to obtain funds to help poor people for food project needs.

B) Well Project Activities: Please pray for Cambodian Ministries for Christ to obtain funds to help poor people for water-well projects in their communities. There is a real need for clean water in remote areas. One well cost \$2,000. Please pray and consider giving funds to help people obtain clean water.

C) Student Support:

Roeun Samnang: Is an orphan receiving \$30 per month from CMC to



help with food, materials, and clothes. She is living with her foster grandmother in Siem Reap. She helps to do housework, takes care of cows, and

cleans up at the CMC Center. **Rama Manickam** is 35-year-old. He is a student who gets a scholarship for \$600



annually from CMC for his three and half years of tuition fees to study. He is studying in second year at Build Bright in the field of

University (BBU), in the field of Information Technology for a bachelor's degree certificate. He studies from Monday-Friday in the



evening from 6:00p.m-9: 15p.m. He finished the first and half year with great results. His second year starts from August 12th. He has received the certificate of Junior Web Developer Contest Season 1. Besides his studies, Rama also is the Administrator at CMC Center in Siem Reap. He has a job to do every day of the week. The work





includes the office and around the center, taking care of the facilities and the building, replacing all the new faucets in the bathrooms, and other things that connect with the sink. He supervises the gardeners and cleaners. Sometimes repairing broken plumbing or electrical. In addition, at night he has to look after the security around the whole CMC center. Sometimes he also helps to look after livestock and trees, preparing the monthly salaries for the staff at CMC. Rama also teaches an English class at the CMC center for a high level of students, he teaches from Monday to Friday each week. He attends church at the CMC center every Sunday, Rama also assists and helps pastor Ravy, helping to prepare the service program on Sunday, prepare worship songs in slide show on that day and controlling sound system during service.

Choun SreyKa A 17-year-old student that CMC started to help. She is living with her grandmather and a brother and



а sister. Currently her parents are laborers working verv hard at animal farms to take care of ducks for a farm owner, they get limited very

income from laborers work to help their family. The support also helps for their daily food to be enough. Financial aid provides food and encourages SreyKa



to attend school until she finishes her terminal degree. SreyKa has three siblings in her family, she is the oldest



child in the family, she is in grade 10 of school. SreyKa received a monthly support through Cambodina Ministries for Christ. The monthly support \$50 per month, she use the support to buy her school meterials, food to help her family and some for her after school fee and English class. The support can help



SreyKa's family improve their lifestyle. After school SreyKa does gardening around her home, helps her parent and grandma take care young broher and sister, and takes other jobs to help her family. SreyK and her family are a christina, she teaches a class of Children's Sunday school at church and attend the church after her Sunday school with Children. She also plays football at her school, she really likes to play football everyday after school.

Ban Mineah A 19 years old of a new student that CMC started to help in



October. Mineah living with her old grandma in the village and two sisters. Currently her parents are laborers working very hard in Thalian, they get very limited

income from laborers work to help their family. The support also helps for their daily food to be enough. Financial aid provides food and encourages Mineah to attend school until she finishes her

Mineah received a monthly support since October through Cambodina Ministries for Christ. After school Mineah does gardening around her home, helps her grandma take care young sisters, and takes other jobs to help her family. Mineah and her family are a christina, she teaches a class of Children's Sunday school at church and attend the church after her Sunday
